

# RIDEF OAXACA 2024 PROGRAM

The RIDEF 2024 program presents the details of all the activities we will carry out.

## **GENERAL ISSUES**

#### **FOOD**

Breakfast will take place every day from 7 to 9 a.m., with the exception of the day of the visit to Tamazulapam which will be from 7 to 8 a.m., and the day of the excursions when it ends at 8:30 a.m. in order to be able to leave early both days.

Lunch will be held from 13 to 15hrs, except on the opening day, which will be from 14 to 16hrs and on the day of the tour to Tamazulapan, which will be from 13 to 14:30 p.m.

Dinner will be served daily from 19:30 to 21hrs, except for the cooperative dinner, which will be from 20 to 21:30hrs.

All meals will be served in the courtyard of the host school, with the exception of the of the *Open Day* (Visit to the Normal School) and of the excursions.

## INTERCULTURAL NIGHTS

The intercultural nights will be held from the 3rd to the 9th day from 21to 22hrs. except the last day, August 10, which will be from 21:30 to 22:30 hrs.

# LONG AND SHORT WORKSHOPS

The long workshops have 1 session of 2 hours, 3 sessions of 4 hours, and 1 session of 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  hours - Total 15  $\frac{1}{2}$  hours.

There will be 3 short workshop sessions, lasting 2 hours. We will open all the necessary rooms to present all the workshops you want to share.

### FIMEM GENERAL ASSEMBLIES

Regarding the GAs, they are scheduled:

- First General Assembly, August 3, with a duration of 2 ½ hours.
- Language group, August 4, with a duration of 2 hours.
- Second General Assembly, August 7, with a duration of 2 ½ hours.
- Third General Assembly, August 10, which will last 2 ½ hours.
- Extraordinary General Assembly, to vote on the change of FIMEM's statutes and regulations will be August 9. Duration 3 hours.
