



RIDEF OAXACA-MEXICO NOTICES BEFORE ARRIVAL

- **Number of participants.** So far, we have 230 participants registered, of which the majority speak Spanish, followed by English and French. There have been some cancellations.
- **Workshops.** Invitations have been sent out to open more long workshops and they are increasing. Once we have more, we open the catalog of workshops so that those who wish to register can do so.
- **T-shirt to print.** You are invited to bring a white or light-colored t-shirt to print the logo of the RIDEF Oaxaca-Mexico 2024 in black and white. The stamping days will be from August 3 to 5 inside the school.
- **There are cases of Dengue in Oaxaca.** There have been cases of dengue in Oaxaca, we believe that by the dates of the RIDEF they will decrease. An information leaflet is attached to take the necessary measures.
- **Weather and climate.** Temperate (warm) climate. Temperature up to 25°C or 30°C. Light to heavy rains.
- **Clothing recommendations.** It is recommended to wear clothing that completely covers arms and legs and footwear that covers the entire foot (Dengue), raincoat, jacket or light sweater.
- **Welcome committee at the airport.** At most arrivals, there will be a welcome committee who will help you get transportation to your hotels in safe taxis or to the bus terminal. These welcomes will be, above all, on the days with the highest number of arrivals.
- **Transportation from Mexico City to Oaxaca City.** The various transportation options from Mexico City to Oaxaca City are attached and placed on the website.
- **Registration at the host school "Moisés Sáenz Secondary School.** When you arrive in the city of Oaxaca, it is important to go to the host school where the registration will take place. At the registration, the card with the information of lodging, food and other information will be given personally.
- **Program changes.** Some adjustments have been made to the program, please check it again.
- **Sports Center.** In the lodging of the Sports Center there are no shelves to store things, however, there will be permanent security since in the shared rooms there is no access to other people. It is important to consider this point in relation to your belongings or valuable documents
